

This is faith, this is love, this is serving God through people and for people but ultimately for god's glory.

Through ups and downs, through good and bad, I'm so grateful for the people in this church, for Fr. Nick and Fr. Vasile and with God's help, with faith and dedication, we will make it to the 100th Anniversary! If not for us, we have to fight the good fight for our children!
